School Closure – A friendly reminder that **NEXT** Wednesday 1 March school will close at 12.30pm for an NZEI Union meeting for all our teachers.

Big Day Out - As you will be aware, postponing the Big Day Out was the right call. We are looking for an alternative date. We will advise you when this is confirmed.

Junior Swimming - ?? Next week ?? Junior swimming for Makomako and Kōtukutuku has been booked for next week at the Fairfield School pool. However we are experiencing great difficulty with the availability of buses for junior swimming, as with all school trips. At this stage we haven't been able to confirm buses for next week (with the fourth company we have tried!). We will confirm via Facebook and Skool Loop tomorrow.

If swimming does go ahead next week children will need to bring togs and towel, and we will need parents to help (must have a current police vet). Buses will leave school at 10.15am, and return at 12.00pm. A final decision will be made tomorrow, and posted on Facebook and Skool Loop.
