



Concord School Compulsory Uniform Procedure

Purpose:

To confirm the items and appearance of our chosen uniform and promote within the school and community the correct and consistent wearing of this uniform by all children, with the understanding that this is compulsory, as decided by the Board of Trustees at the December 2009 meeting.

Uniform List:

The uniform colours consist of navy and light blue, and items are available at Promo-X and The Warehouse in South Dunedin, or the second-hand uniform shop at school.

Items are to be chosen from the following:

- Navy polar fleece top with embroidered school logo
- Navy A-line skirt or culottes
- Blue tartan culottes
- Blue tartan box pleat pinafore
- Navy drill short
- Navy cargo pants
- Navy double knee track pant
- Sky blue short/long sleeved polo shirt

Additional items:

- Shoes – these must be lace up, buckled, or velcro flat school-type or track-type shoes or sandals in black or brown. No jandals, slip-ons or high heels allowed
- Sunhat – a navy blue bucket hat that is supplied by the SunSmart Schools programme, or Concord School. The hats remain the property of Concord School

Procedures:

- There is a choice of a variety of tops and bottoms to meet the varying needs of children
- All thermal tops and bottoms, tights etc., that can be seen must be in keeping with the colour scheme, i.e. navy or light blue.
- Children who arrive at school either out of uniform or with some non-uniform items will be:
 - Given replacement items to wear for the day, which must be returned within two days, washed
 - Given a warning note

Saying the uniform is in the wash will not be accepted as a reason for non-wearing
