went into makeup, making some children quite unrecognisable! We held the disco on Halloween night itself this year as an alternative to 'trick or treating', which can be stressful for families.

Thanks to all the Parents' Group for organising this fun event for our tamariki.

Welcome to Livi – We recently welcomed student teacher Livi Wells to Rātā room, and hope that she enjoys her four weeks here.

Teacher Only Day – We will be having our final Teacher Only Day for the year on **Monday 20**th **November**. The staff will be working on Te Mātaiaho, the refreshed NZ curriculum.

CARE Assembly – Yesterday at our weekly CARE Assembly we talked about a range of emotions. We focused on feeling frustrated and angry, and that it is OK to feel this way. It is important to know our trigger points that bring these emotions on, and how to deal with them.

I explained that one of my trigger points is getting home and finding that my boys have left the living room in a mess eg plates, cups, bowls, socks, shoes etc lying around. I have previously become angry and raised my voice at them to tidy up, which is usually ineffective.

I have found a better strategy is to initially calm down using various breathing strategies eg 'square breathing' or 5-finger breathing, which I demonstrated at the assembly. By taking the time to calm down first, I can then have a more effective conversation with my boys, which will lead to a more successful outcome.

My boys are on study leave from today, so I am now well prepared for these upcoming situations!

Golf Lessons – All classes enjoyed a sunny day of golf lessons here at school on Monday with the St Clair golf professional, Patrick. These will be held again next Monday, weather permitting.

Concord Kindergarten Visit – Yesterday Kōtukutuku class walked to the kindy and had a great time playing and reading with the children. Many thanks to the whānau who went with them.
