Kia ora whānau

Retirement - Our Deputy Principal and Kōtukutuku teacher Fay Young will retire from teaching at the end of this year. Fay has been teaching at our school for 30 years across various year levels. She has led the school and staff with the maths curriculum, the Duffy Book Programme, and she has spent countless hours, especially in the holidays, keeping the library in tip top shape.

Fay is often the first staff member here in the morning and does a lot of the 'unseen' work like putting out the road cones and wet weather flags, often in the dark. Fay has also made a very valuable contribution to the governance of the school as the staff representative on the board of trustees for 22 years. At a personal level Fay as Deputy Principal has been invaluable in supporting me in my role and I will miss our regular conversations and her advice.

Fay has given outstanding service over the years to the students, staff and whānau of Concord School and she will be missed. We will be holding a special assembly for Fay on **Tuesday 12**th **December** at 2.15pm. We hope you will be able to attend.

2024 Classes - At the end of the year we will be saying farewell to 17 Year 6 students when they move on to their new schools. This is the largest group of school leavers that we have had for some time. As we have had fewer new entrant students this year it does mean that our staffing has decreased for 2024 therefore we will have three classes next year.

Our experienced staff are experts at multi-year level teaching, as being in a smaller school this is what we have been doing for years. You can be assured that your child/ren will get the best education at Concord School and they will not miss any opportunities due to having three classes. At present there are numerous Dunedin schools experiencing a decrease in classrooms, the new entrant numbers have been low for the last couple of years across the city.

2024 classes are being finalised and should be available at the end of next week.

Hypafix Dressings – If your child has had a scraped knee or similar accident at school you may have noticed a white dressing has been used. This is called Hypafix dressing and is recommended by medical professionals as it is a low allergy adhesive, excellent for healing, waterproof, and stays on, unlike regular plasters.

The dressing can be left on for up to a week, and removed by just soaking the area

with water (bath time is ideal) or cooking oil to soften it, then gently peel it off. We still use regular plasters for minor cuts.
