Kia ora whānau

Welcome back to all children, parents and teachers. I hope you had a relaxing summer break and you were able to do some fun things with your family.

It was great to see many smiley faces on Tuesday, including many parents who were looking forward to having their uninterrupted coffee time. I have noticed my house is decidedly tidier without the boys being at home all day.

**Role Models -** This week in classes and at assembly we talked about what you have to do to be a role model and who the role models are in our lives. These are some of the students responses:

**Role models:** make the right decisions; are respectful of themselves and others; follow the CARE expectations; are honest and trustworthy; others look up to them

Role models in our life: parents; teachers; wider whanau eg: grandparents, aunties, uncles; brothers and sisters; often older children at school; coaches; and sometimes celebrities can also be role models

We often ask the children to be a role model to others eg: to new students in the class or younger students, although we regularly need to unpack the meaning of this, with examples for our students to relate to. We also discuss that we make mistakes from time to time, though we use these mistakes as learning opportunities. We will continue these conversations.

Parents are at the top of the role model list, as this was mentioned first by the students and rightly so. You spend the most time with your tamariki and you have the biggest influence on your child/ren. Being a role model doesn't stop at the gate, it occurs everywhere eg at the local park, watching sports from the sideline, on social media, driving a car and at school.

With the Big Day Out happening next week I have enclosed our **Community Conduct Expectations** that are also available with all other school policies on our SchoolDocs website. We want every day at Concord School to be a safe and inclusive environment where everyone feels welcome and everyone belongs. I thank you in advance for your continued support and for being a positive role model for all our Tamariki.

**Big Day Out** – This year we are holding our Big Day Out next Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> February, with the reserve day being Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February.

We will be leaving school at 9.30am, heading first to the Taieri Aerodrome then walking to the Mosgiel park, then the Mosgiel pool, returning to school by 3.00pm. We still need a few parents to come with us – bring your lunch and your togs! School lunches will be delivered to the park. Children will need to bring a drink bottle, morning tea, swimming togs and towel, and warm clothing.

Free Healthy School Lunches – We are again having our lunches provided by 'Time 4 Lunch'. Please supply your child with a healthy snack (eg not packaged food) for morning tea, and a drink bottle, each day.

**Stationery** – Stationery lists were sent home this week. Please purchase this as soon as possible as it is important that children have all their stationery to get their year's school work properly under way. All items are available for purchase from the school office if you wish – please send the completed list to the office and orders will be made up and given to your child.

Futsal/Touch - Notices went home this week regarding this term's Futsal and Touch Rugby. Teams have to be entered soon so please return the forms asap. Teams will not be entered if we do not have coaches and/or managers for each team. No expertise required.
