'Big Day Out' – We had a very successful 'Big Day Out' yesterday with the weather playing its part, and some fun experiences for everyone, including the helicopters, Te Puna o Whakaehu (Mosgiel pool) and the Mosgiel park. I was especially proud of our older students who took on the responsibility of supporting the younger students during the day.

It was great to be able to walk along the Whakaehu (Silverstream) and talk about the legend of the taniwha Matamata sliding along the river and forming the hollow which is now the Taieri Plain. When the taniwha died it formed Saddle Hill, with its two main humps named Puke Makamaka, which we can see from our school, and Turi Makamaka. We have been learning about the legend this term and it has been the basis of our current art work.

Thanks again to all the whānau who came with us. We couldn't do amazing trips like this without your ongoing support.


