**Big Day Out** – Tomorrow we will be heading out on our Big Day Out! We will leave school and take buses to the Botanical Gardens, where students will participate in a range of activities. Students are still required to wear their school uniform.

We will be leaving school at 9.15am, returning to school by 3.00pm. Many thanks to all the whānau who have offered to come with us – please bring your own lunch, drink bottle etc.

If you don't yet have the Skool Loop app, it is free to download from Google Play and the App Store – search 'Skool Loop' and choose our school once it is installed.

It's very simple to book - click on the 'Bookings' link on the front page, click on Wed 26- Thurs 27, click on the teacher's name, tick the day you prefer and the time you want – done! If you are unable to make any of the times available, please contact your child's teacher. Please contact the school office with any queries.

It is important that parents and students are all present at the interviews to set achievable goals with everyone's input.
