'Keeping Ourselves Safe' - Over the coming weeks, our school will be delivering the Keeping Ourselves Safe programme, in partnership with NZ Police. This important programme helps teach our tamariki how to keep themselves safe in a range of situations—both in person and online.

It covers topics such as identifying unsafe situations, understanding personal boundaries, and knowing how and when to ask for help. Lessons are tailored to be age-appropriate and are delivered in a safe, supportive way by classroom

teachers, with input from our local Police Education Officer.

We encourage you to talk with your child about what they're learning as the programme progresses. If you have any questions or would like more information, please don't hesitate to get in touch with the school


